On YouTube that song got possibly one of the dumbest comments I've ever received for my music.

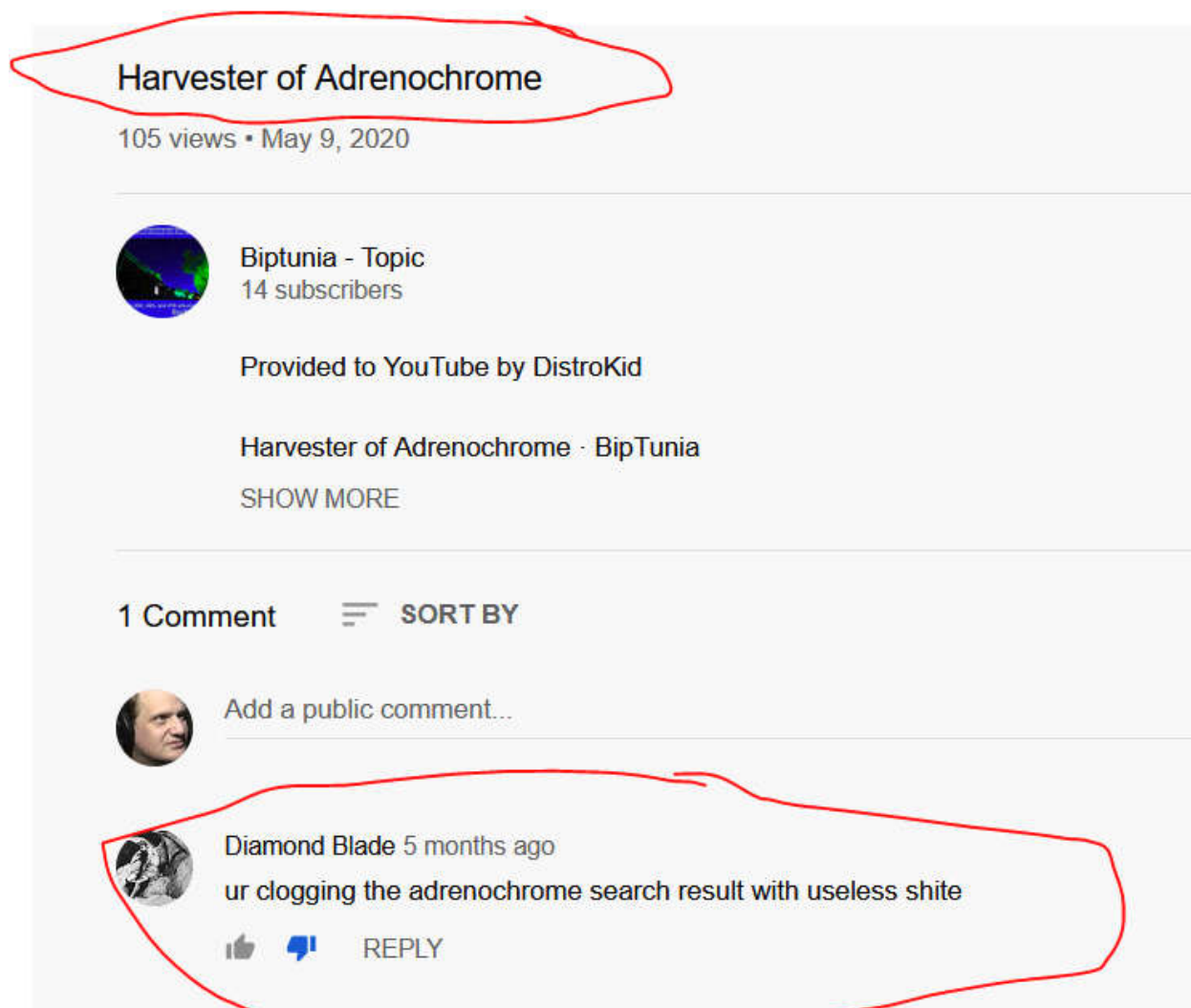
Someone who believes the conspiracy, and is unaware of how the Internet works, said this:
